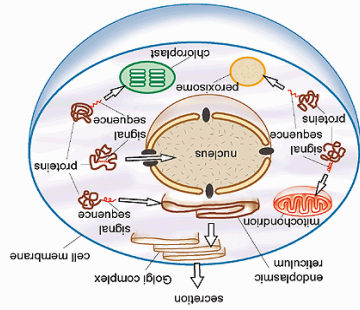
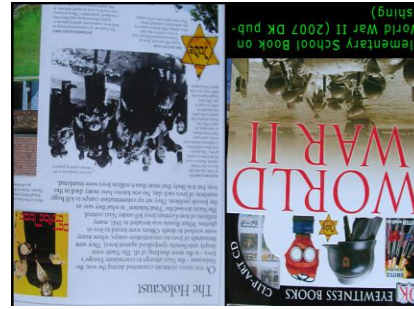
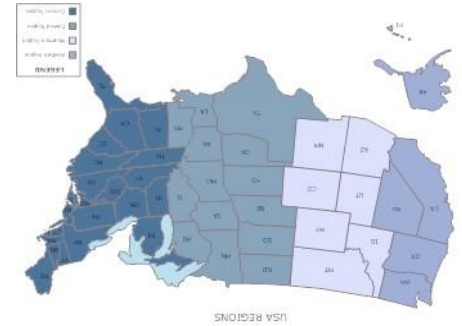


Diagram:

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Glossary:
lists new or
important words
and tells what they
mean at end of text

middle: the part of something that isn't an end, or, from the ends.
midnight: a time that is at about the middle of the day from midnight.
midpoint: the point at the middle of a line segment
mile (abbr. mi): the same length as 5,280 feet or 1,609 meters.
miles per hour (abbr. mph): how many miles you travel in one hour.
milli-: 1 thousandth; 1/1,000.
A millimeter is 1/1,000 of a meter.
milligram: one thousandth of a gram.
milliliter (abbr. mL):
1. a small measurement of liquid. Look at a cone.
2. one thousandth of a liter. A milliliter is equal to one cubic centimeter.
millimeter (abbr. mm): 1 thousandth of a meter; 1/1,000 of a meter.
million: a thousand thousands.
